Notes- The above goods were picked up from the home of Shozo SAKATA, 36 Moncton St., Steveston, B.C. SAKATA did not declare any chattels left in the protected area other than those which were inventoried by the Custodian. The Custodian wrote SAKATA on July 3, 1943 and again on April 19th, 1945, asking him to advise us if these goods belonged to him or his brothers Eiichi and Tomio SAKATA, both of whom claimed goods left in his care. Also Takaharu HAKAMITSU claimed goods left at 36 Moncton Street. As no answer was received from both of these inquiries, we are today transferring all funds derived from the sale of these chattels to "Suspense" until such time as all files are reviewed and credit properly given.


