Dear Sir:

Replying to your letter of September 21st re Minoru Adachi #09028.

We beg to advise that the Japanese formerly living here stored their household goods in the Japanese Hall at Palei, but just what was stored in this hall, the Company has no way of knowing, as we were not given a list or a record of each individual's personal property.

The understanding with Mr. T. Urabe, the Japanese Foreman while working for this Company, was that they could store their chattels in the hall and we would ship out anything they ordered, if it was possible. Since then, we have shipped considerable items to them as per instructions from your office. Records of which we have here. But as to what is left in the hall, we have no record.

We shipped for M. Adachi six pieces as per your order dated July 27th signed by Mr. J. A. Rose of the B. C. Security Commission.
