Dear Madam:

We are in receipt of your letter of the 19th instant which evidently refers to your letter of the 5th instant regarding the chattels of your relatives. Their files have been reviewed and we have the following to report:

Miyeko SATO, File 11181, Reg. No. 05656:

When the declarant registered at the office of the Custodian she stated that she had no personal or other property in this area. We did not find any chattels in her name.

Shizuko FUNE, File No. 9145, Reg. No. 03519:

When the declarant registered with the Custodian on May 15th, 1942, she declared no property of any description in this area. Then on October 14th, 1942, she declared that she was leaving twelve packages of chattels at the B. C. Purchasers Office, 573 East Hastings Street, Vancouver. It is noted that a Custodian Release was issued for shipment of these goods from 573 East Hastings Street. We did not recover any chattels in the name of Shizuko FUNE.

Matsuyo SATO, File 11190, Reg. No. 02384:

When registering with the Custodian the above declared her intention of leaving chattels in the B. C. Purchasers Office, 573 East Hastings Street. It is noted that a Custodian release was issued for shipment of chattels from this address to the above. We did not recover any chattels in the name of Matsuyo SATO.

Juzo SATO, File 12477, Reg. No. 05905:

When registering with the Custodian the above declared no property of any description in this area. Notwithstanding this declaration, we note that a Custodian Release was issued in his name for shipment of chattels from 573 East Hastings Street. We did not recover any chattels from 573 E. Hastings Street in the name of Juzo SATO.

The property at 573 East Hastings Street (B. C. Purchasers Co-operative Association) was supervised by Messrs. Norris & McLennan, the legal representatives, who kept the key to the property. When it was decided that the chattels should be removed from this place, we accompanied Mr. McLennan and when the building was opened, it was discovered that thieves had ransacked the contents of the building and everything was left in a most chaotic condition. Under the circumstances we regret that we are unable to submit a more favourable report.
