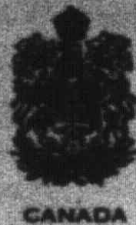





Referring to your letter of the 6th inst., regarding three claims lodged against the above named, we have now heard from our New Denver Supervisor who writes as follows:-

"...This man acknowledges that these accounts are correct. The above man was a T.B. case for many years and was on relief in Vancouver for 1½ years before evacuation. He has been on relief ever since his arrival here. The latest Doctor's report on this man states there is only half of one lung functioning and he can do no work of any kind."

In view of the above we fear there is little hope of Mr OKAHORI being able to make any arrangements for settlement of debts at this time.
