Dear Madam:

This is to inform you that, on December 20, 1945, we sent your camera to you by insured parcel post. This camera should now be in your hands. The cost of mailing the camera was 21 cents, made up of 16 cents for postage and five cents for packing costs. This sum was deducted from funds standing to your credit with this office.

As you were advised previously, your radio was sold for the net amount of \$39.01. After deducting the cost of mailing your camera, your credit balance is \$38.80, and we enclose herewith our cheque for this amount.

In your declaration to the Custodian on May 15, 1942, you stated that you owned no property of any kind left in the protected area. Your camera and radio, which were reported to this office by the Royal Canadian Mounted Police, are the only items of property belonging to you of which this office has any knowledge, and these have now been accounted for.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which vested in the Custodian and, in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque and camera, we enclose a stamped, addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.

The radio was sold and the net proceeds of this sale, in the amount of \$39.01, were credited to the account of Kimiko SHIGEISHI. The camera was mailed to Kimiko SHIGEISHI on December 20, 1945, by this office.
