
Dr. UCHIDA has withdrawn his claim.

This file reveals that OYAMA owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

MONEYS RECEIVABLE: The account of OYAMA was credited with the sum of \$5.06, being a refund of 1% wage deductions for the first six months of 1941.

His account has also been credited with the sum of \$.28, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.
