

The camera was mailed to Mrs. KITASAKI, by the Custodian, on January 17th, 1946. The cost of shipping this camera was 20 cents, which was charged to her account. The radio was sold for the net sum of \$43.36, which has been credited to her account.

Dear Madam:

Enclosed herewith is Custodian's cheque in the amount of \$43.16, representing all the funds standing to your credit with the Custodian.

In your declaration to the Custodian you reported six Prudential Life Insurance Policies on your life and the lives of five of your children. These did not come under the control of this office.

The radio which you surrendered to the Police was sold for the net sum of \$43.36, which was credited to your account.

The camera which you surrendered was sent to you on January 17th, by Insured Parcel Post. Cost of mailing this camera was 20 cents, made up of postage 15 cents and packing charge 5 cents. This sum has been deducted from the radio money as you requested. This leaves a credit balance of \$43.16 in your account which is being remitted to you herewith.

It would appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the Protected Area, which vested in the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheque, we enclose a stamped addressed envelope for your convenience and reply.
