Dear Sir:

At the outbreak of the Pacific war we surrendered our all-wave radio to the authorities as was then required. Now, I should like to request the return of this radio, since I am certain that possession of this apparatus no longer constitutes a menace of importance. Furthermore, it seems likely that at some near future date we shall be compelled to reinstate ourselves outside of B.C.; then, of course, there will be no reason for not returning this radio. You are entitled, if necessary, to remove essential parts so as to prevent the apparatus.

only to use the radio as a means
of musical reception and reproduction
I assume that the radio has not
been inadvertently sold as yet: we
have neither requested nor agreed
with such a sale. The radio is
owned by Iwakichi Sugiyama —
without whose knowledge I am
