It appears that Tetsuo Tamemoto removed his chattels from No. 2 Dyke Rd., Steveston, to the Great West Cannery, after making his declaration to the Custodian. When the chattels found at the Great Hest Connery were inventoried by the Custodian's agent, they were done so under the name of Tetauo Tamemoto. You also declared that you left goods at the Great West Campery, but as these goods were not tagged with the proper names, they too were removed under the name of Tetsuo.
