On the back of Mrs. Ono's Form J card it was stated that she owed \$25.00 to Mrs. A. Yoshida, a friend, but had no money to pay the debt. On taking up this matter with Mrs. Ono under date of February 5th, 1946, she stated she was sure that she had not borrowed any money from Mrs. Yoshida.

In view of the fact that Mrs. Yoshida has not made any claim against Mrs. Ono for the money in question, and as Mrs. Ono has no funds with the Custodian it was decided to take no further action in the matter beyond sending a copy to Mrs. Yoshida of our letter of February 8, 1946 to Mrs. Ono, in which we stated we would not pursue the matter.


Please note that the above Japanese has been repatriated to Japan. The following is the status of his account with this Department, covering the repatriation transactions:

We can only repeat that on the back of the "No Property" declaration card made by you on May 16, 1942 there is a note to the effect that you stated you owed \$25.00 to a friend (Mrs. A. Yoshida, 221 W. 5th Ave., Vancouver) and that you were unable to pay the debt as you had no money.

In view of the fact that no mention of this debt is made by Mrs. A. Yoshida in her declaration, we do not propose to go further into this matter and as Mrs. A. Yoshida is at Tashme, if there is any money owing by you to her we shall leave the matter of settlement between you.

We are sending a copy of this letter to Mrs. Yoshida for her information.
