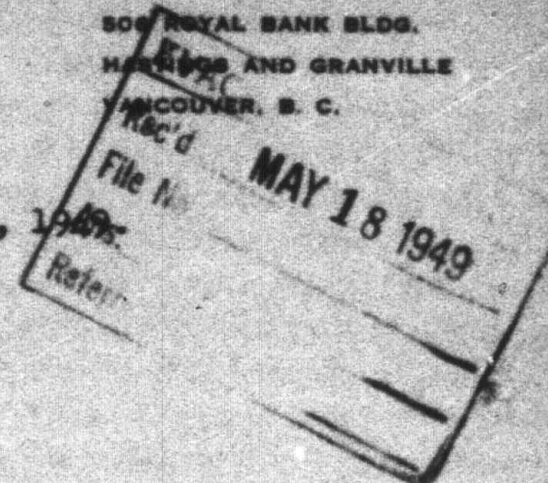

Further to our letter of the 8th instant, we attach hereto Custodian cheque in the amount of \$726.29, which represents the distribution from the Riverayde Lumber Company Limited of your 2,201 shares at the rate of 32.998 cents per share.

In your letter to us of September 8th, 1947, you stated that your brother, Kaichi SHIKAZE, who returned to Japan on June 16th, 1946, had requested you to receive the balance of funds amounting to \$571.02, from the distribution of his shares. You say that you have nothing to go by, and therefore we cannot pay this amount to you without authority from Mr. SHIKAZE. Will you write to Kaichi SHIKAZE in Japan, requesting him to write to this office and authorize us to pay this money to you? In the meantime these funds are being held in this office pending this authority, and not being sent to Mr. SHIKAZE in Japan as would be the general practice.

We also have for the credit of Jujiro SAMEJIMA the sum of \$49.49, being the distribution on his 150 shares of the Riverayde Lumber Company Limited, but we have no record on our files for this man, and we would appreciate it if you will advise us if this is the same person as Jujiro SAMEJIMA, who worked for you as a saw-mill worker in Mission, B. C. If the name should be SAMESHIMA, could you tell us his whereabouts in order that we may communicate with him?
