This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 16, 1942. He was evacuated on October 3, 1942.

In his declaration he stated that he owned household furnishings, personal effects, etc. at 236 Powell Street. The house at 236 Powell Street was owned by Genji HAYASHI, Internee File No. 766. On March 28, 1944 we notified Yoshihiro WADA that we could find no chattels belonging to him, and that we understood that he had disposed of these during the six months that elapsed between the date of his declaration and his evacuation. No reply was received to our letter.

He declared 3 \$5.00 War Savings Certificates in his possession. These did not come under the control of this office.

This file and the file of this man's wife reveal no other property.

Mr. Spain reports to Mr. Wright 19/2/43 on
Int. file 766:-

236 Powell Street

"I have inspected the above premises and agree with the City Building Inspectors that the central and rear portion of the building should be demolished....
.....The place is very dirty..... and whilst every room has some furniture, not one piece justifies removal to central storage."

On February 26th, 1943, Messenger writes "I received verbal instructions from Mr. Wright to accept an offer for the few remaining chattels on the above premises, made by Mr. Peter Hem, in an amount of \$15.00."

It seems reasonable to assume that this Japanese made his own arrangements for his belongings as he was not evacuated until October, and a letter has been addressed to him accordingly.


