PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: UMEZUKI, Chiyo (Mrs. Takaichi) - Reg. No. 10137.

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on March 16, 1942 and was evacuated on June 3, 1942.

CHATTELS: She declared 3 beds complete, a washing machine, kitchen utensils, Singer Sewing Machine and a stove. She stated that she desired to take the beds, washing machine and sewing machine, as well as stove, with her and would otherwise leave them at 1023 McLean St. On June 8, 1942, Takaichi UMEZUKI husband of the above, declared that she had been evacuated and that she had left 1 Box and 2 Beds, to be moved by the Custodian. The file reveals that 3 beds and 1 box were moved to 992 Powell St. on June 19, 1942 and removed from there, by Takaichi UMEZUKI, on October 20, 1942. T. UMEZUKI's declaration of June 8, 1942 also stated that Kahoru TAKAYESU, File 8984, had left 2 trunks and 4 beds at 1023 MacLean Street. Only 3 beds were removed in her name while 3 instead of 2 were moved in the name of Mrs. UMEZUKI. It appears that Mrs. UMEZUKI and Mrs. TAKAYESU are related and it is presumed that Mrs. TAKAYESU was aware that one of her beds was taken by Takaichi UMEZUKI.

Chiyo UMEZUKI declared a dog and stated that she would see that it was disposed of. We presume that she did so.

BANK

ACCOUNTS: She declared an account in the Royal Bank, Main & Hastings Branch with a credit balance of \$8.00. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

LIFE

INSURANCE: She declared 5 insurance policies with the Prudential Insurance Co., the policies being in her possession. None of these were brought under the control of the Custodian.

This file reveals no other property.
