re: Green Cove Salteries Ltd. - \$89.26

We are just in receipt of your letter of the 23rd inst. regarding your claim as above against this company and we wish to say in reply that your previous letters of January 10th, January 21st, and March 26th received prompt attention.

Messrs. P.S. Ross and Sons, Royal Bank Building, Vancouver, who are looking after the affairs of the Green Cove Salteries Ltd., were written to at different times submitting your claim and asking for a reply, but so far without definite result. This has perhaps been due to the fact that the affairs of the Salteries Company seem to be in a "rather bad way" as we stated to you in our letter of the 19th of January.

You say, "Surely a small claim of \$89.26 could be settled quickly". This may seem so, but when a company is in liquidation, all claims have to be listed and take pro rata whatever is realized from the assets.

Your claim is receiving the usual attention, and should P.S. Ross and Sons reply to our letter of today regarding your claim we shall advise you of what they say.

Please note that Mr. Yoshikazu Karatsu, Police Registration No. 12062, dealt with by our file No. 9354, has a claim against the Green Cove Salteries, Ltd. for \$89.26 in connection with a cheque for that amount issued by Mr. Masao Kashino as Manager of the Green Cove Salteries, Ltd.

In brief, it is our understanding that Mr. Masao Kashino, at the request of Mr. Yoshikazu Karatsu in November, 1941, purchased from Messrs. McLennan, McFeely & Prior, Ltd. certain fishing supplies for something in excess of \$100.00, and when accompanying Mr. Karatsu to Mc & Mc and to avoid unnecessary bookkeeping entries, that Mr. Karatsu paid cash on the spot to Mc & Mc. At that point war broke out, fishing was prohibited, and Mr. Karatsu therefore, with Mr. Kashino's consent and with the consent of Mc & Mc, returned some of this equipment to Mc & Mc and asked for a cash refund. He was then advised by Mc & Mc that relative articles had been purchased in the name of the Green Cove Salteries, Ltd. and that a credit slip for \$89.26 would be forwarded to the Green Cove Salteries by Mc & Mc and this was done. Mr. Karatsu then went to Mr. Kashino who gave to Mr. Karatsu a cheque for \$89.26. The cheque was deposited by the Karatsus and their account was debited with the same amount as soon as the bank learned that the cheque was no good.

We would appreciate your advising us as to the prospects of this claim for \$89.26 being paid in full.
