PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARY

April 19/47

RE: Isojiro KOBAYASHI, Reg. No. 00681

This file reveals that KOBAYASHI owned no real property in any protected area of B.C. and did not carry any Fire Insurance.

CHATELS: KOBAYASHI declared chattels as shown on Chattel Schedule on file. According to information received from Mr. Daly, the owner of the house at 1519 W. 3rd Ave. where the KOBAYASHI family lived, one of the sons remained in town for a few weeks after the remainder of the family had been evacuated in order to dispose of the furniture and effects for his father. As no chattels were found at this address it would appear that the disposal of the chattels had been completed by the son. Mrs. KOBAYASHI did not register with the Custodian.

MONEYS The account of KOBAYASHI was credited with the sum of \$4.94, being a  
RECEIVABLE: refund of 1% wage deductions for the first 6 months of 1941.

His account was also credited with the sum of \$1.27, being a refund of security deposit for light from the B.C.E.R.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.

A Mr. W. Daly owned the house at 1519 W. 3rd Ave. where the KOBAYASHI family lived. In letters dated April 13/42 and April 30/42, Mr. Daly mentions that KOBAYASHI had not left the key to the house with him and that there still appeared to be goods belonging to KOBAYASHI in the house. In a letter dated May 2/44 Mr. Daly states that although Mr. KOBAYASHI himself had left Vancouver, that his son was still in town living in the house and that this son was going to dispose of the furniture and effects for the family. As no chattels were found in the house when Mr. Daly did get the key to the building, it would appear that the son had disposed of all the chattels prior to his evacuation.

re: Isosiro KOBAYASHI, Reg. No. 00681

We submitted a claim of yours for rent from February 15th to May 15th 1942 for \$42.00 to KOBAYASHI for payment. He has replied as follows:

"First the rent. I was evacuated to the road camp on March 21st and the family out to the Okanagan on the 5th of March which means that the house was vacant. Our sudden leave was beyond our control and with great excitement at that time I had no means of notifying Mr. Daly therefore."

In looking up our records it seems that his statement, as above, regarding himself is correct, as the R.C.M.P. report that he entrained for Valemont, Alberta, on March 23rd, 1942. KOBAYASHI states that the family went to the Okanagan on the 5th of March, 1942.

If the foregoing is the correct information it does not appear that you would be entitled to more than about a month and a half rent, in view of his compulsory departure from 1519 West 3rd Avenue, Vancouver.

We are not assuming to argue the case, but it would seem that \$21.00 might very well satisfy your claim in full. We do not know what his ability to pay is, nor whether he would agree to pay the above amount, but you might let us know if you would accept \$21.00 in full settlement.


