This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 7, 1942. He was evacuated on June 29, 1942. In his declaration he reported the following assets:

Securities: Victory Bond \$50.00 & War Savings Stamps \$10.00 in his own possession. These did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Life Insurance: Sun Life Policy #2272389 \$1,000.00, Beneficiary, his mother, Kiku, in Japan. In a later declaration of June 18, 1942, he stated the beneficiary of this policy was his wife. This policy did not come under the control of the Custodian.

Chattels: In his second declaration, June 18, 1942, he reported one trunk of clothing and one box of kitchen utensils in care of Matt Brown, Cumberland. These articles were shipped to him, care of the B. C. Security Commission on June 15, 1942.

This file reveals no property of any kind whatsoever.
