PERSONAL PROPERTY SUMMARYRe: NISHIZAKI, Kimi (Mrs. Yosomatsu) - Reg. No. 01384

The above signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 18, 1942 and was evacuated on June 25, 1942.

CHATELS: She declared that she resided at 875 West 7th. Ave., Vancouver, B.C. with her father, Tomekichi HIKIDA, File 3057. She declared Chinaware and Kitchen utensils left at 875 West 7th. Ave. On September 5, 1942 we advised her that we had been informed that she had disposed of her effects and asked to confirm that this was the case. She did not reply.

However, a box of glassware and another of crockery were sold in Auction Vancouver 16, for the net sum of \$1.20 and credited to her account. These boxes were moved from 925 West 7th. together with the goods belonging to Gihei HIKIDA, her brother, who owned the real property. These goods were separated in our warehouse and sold by auction for the credit of Gihei HIKIDA, File 707, his wife, Kikue HIKIDA, File 9454 and Takeo KITAMURA, File 15012, brother-in-law of Gihei HIKIDA. There appears to be little doubt that the goods credited to Mrs. NISHIZAKI belong to her as they agree with her declaration. She evidently moved them from her father's house to her brother's sometime between her declaration and evacuation.

A memorandum from the B. C. Security Commission, dated August 10, 1942 reveals that Mrs. NISHIZAKI had 5 articles stored at Crone's Warehouse and that she desired these to be shipped. The file does not confirm this shipment, but, in the absence of further requests it would appear that this was done.

BONDS: Mrs. NISHIZAKI declared \$100.00 Victory Bond, and \$95.00 in War Savings Certificates, belonging to her husband and which she had in her possession. These were not brought under the control of the Custodian.

BANK

ACCOUNTS: She declared an account - No. 1258, with a balance of \$3,000.00 with the Royal Bank of Canada, Broadway and Cambie branch. This was not brought under the control of the Custodian.

This file reveals no other property of any kind.

Mr. Nishizaki as yet has not registered with the Custodian and our Registration Department is getting into touch with him in this connection. Following receipt of Mr. Nishizaki's JP registration form duly completed, we shall be happy to consider Mr. Nishizaki's request sympathetically. In the meantime, the sum of \$29.47 stands to his credit with us.

For your information Mrs. Nishizaki registered with the Custodian on May 18, 1942, and declared at that time that she was holding a \$100.00 Victory Bond and \$95.00 in War Savings Certificates belonging to her husband, and Mrs. Nishizaki also stated that her account No. 1258 in the Broadway and Cambie branch, Vancouver, of the Royal Bank of Canada had a balance of \$3000.00. This information may be of some interest to you.
