





Reference your letter of 22nd inst, with regard to the above man, I hasten to advise you that this man never worked for the Nanaimo Shipyards, but was employed by Canadian Saltery Ltd., and his address appears on the Form 57-1 slip as Talihoe, B. C.

As far as I can gather the confusion was caused by the mention of two distinct persons in your letter of August 10th, 1942. The reference to Nanaimo Shipyards had to do with Yokichi FURUMOTO, P.O. Box 367, Nanaimo, B. C., refund \$4.29, for which you have received a cheque.

I hope that this explanation will clear up the matter for you and regret that you were unduly inconvenienced.

Thank you very much indeed for your letter dated January 25th, identifying Mr. Tsunekichi Fujinami as employed by the Canadian Saltery Ltd. We appreciate your clearing this matter up for us.

Upon reviewing our records we find letter dated August 3, 1942 under file No. 848-X-1001 addressed by Mr. Brown, the Provincial Assessor, to the Nanaimo Shipyards Ltd. in the attachments to which the following four individuals are listed presumably as former employees of the Nanaimo Shipyards Ltd.

Mr. Yokichi Furumoto, Police Registration No. 02026, has been correctly identified as a former employee of the Nanaimo Shipyards Ltd. and we have forwarded to him refund of \$4.29 covering 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ wage deduction for the first six months of 1941. Mr. N. Fujimoto has been identified as Mr. Noboru Fujimoto, Police Registration No. 06902, and our records indicate that he was never in the employ of the Nanaimo Shipyards Ltd. but was in fact employed by the Deep Bay Logging Company at Fanny Bay, B. C. We have forwarded to him the sum of \$3.26 covering his 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ wage deduction refund.

Mr. T. Fujinami has been identified as Mr. Tsunekichi Fujinami, Police Registration No. 00124, and our records indicate that he was never in the employ of the Nanaimo Shipyards Ltd and your letter dated January 25th confirms that he was an employee of the Canadian Saltery Ltd. We are today forwarding to him a cheque for \$1.17 covering refund to him of his 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ wage deduction.
