




This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of 22nd instant enclosing authority signed by the above for you to handle her affairs after her return to Japan. We are returning this document to you and also the Notice of Registration of Death of her husband, which was also sent us with your letter.

Kuro KIDO, Deceased, was the registered owner of 121 shares of Maple Ridge Co-Operative Produce Exchange. He owed the Co-Operative \$21.87 and they cancelled 22 of the above shares to pay off the account owing, remitting to us the balance of \$9.134 which we credited to KIDO'S account. This was included in the amount later transferred to the widow's account from the Estate account and was taken to Japan by Mrs. Kido with her other money.

The 99 shares remaining have now been redeemed at \$1.27755 per share and the proceeds \$126.48 credited to the account of Mrs. Kido in this office. This amount will be handed to the Treasury Department of the Dominion Government with our usual remittance in August next and by then sent in the usual way to Japan for Mrs. Kido.

We trust that this is the information you require.
