Mrs. HARA, on the 18th of May 1942, declared that she had no property of any kind whatsoever in any Protected Area of British Columbia. Later, on September 21st, 1942, she made additional registration, indicating as owing to her by Mr. Levat, Whonnock, B.C., \$125.00, as per copy of memorandum of that date attached herewith.

Nothing more appears on the file 9482, hence we are closing same, as you are handling everything on Internee 564, Kiyoji HARA.

We are in receipt of Prisoner of War Business Letter
from above named as follows:

"I wish you will kindly send Seventy-Five Dollars out of my credit
to my wife, Mrs. Fusaye HARA, of House #4, 6th Ave. Bay Park, Slocan,
B. C. for the cost of her false teeth at your earliest convenience.

The last remittance of \$90.00 to her was spent mostly for clothings
of my family, because the Welfare Association not only provided to
my family required clothings but suggested and made her to get
clothings with that remittance.

Therefore, I wish you will kindly notify to the agent of the B.C.
Security Commission of the district, that not to force her to spend
the remittance of this time towards clothings or any other purposes
at last time, nor to suggest her to make a temporary false teeth as
last occasion, and use the balance for other means."

Enclosed herewith please find cheque in the amount of
\$75.00 which we would ask you to kindly forward to Mrs. Fusaye HARA
at above address, to cover cost of her false teeth. Please be good
enough to acknowledge receipt of cheque to this office.
