Dear Sirs

We have today received an undated letter from your son, Takeshi KUNITOMO, requesting the funds standing to the credit of your account with this office. He advises that you are unable to write English and you require the money as soon as possible for the purchase of a house. In accordance with the above request, which has also been signed by you, we enclose herewith Custodian cheques in the sum of \$489.69, representing your entire credit with this office.

On January 3rd, 1946, you were forwarded a statement relating to the sale of Lot 15, known as 2145 West 13th Avenue, Vancouver, together with a statement of your account, which showed a credit balance of \$489.69 in your account as at December 13th, 1944, the amount of the cheques now enclosed.

We are forwarding a copy of this letter to your son, Takeshi Kunitomo, for his information.

It would now appear that we have accounted for all the property of every kind left by you in the protected area which came under the control of the Custodian, and in order that you may confirm this and acknowledge the cheques we are enclosing a stamped and addressed envelope for your convenience in replying.
