We are in receipt of certified copy of Letters of Administration appointing you administrator with will annexed, of the above estate.

We also acknowledge certified copy of the Last Will and Testament of your late father which provides that all his estate both real and personal are to be distributed to his wife Haruo for as long as she shall live, and then to be equally divided among all his children then living.

We now have to advise you that according to information on our file your father at the time of his death owned the following:

The cash on hand represents one-half of the balance of proceeds from sale of the real property after the Victory Bonds were purchased, together with interest from these bonds.
