Dear Madam:

We regret to hear of the death of your husband, Teruichi Abe. Upon reviewing our administration of his affairs, we find that the only assets he declared to the Custodian were household effects at 614 Alexander Street, Vancouver. These articles were not located by the Custodian and no reply was received from Mr. Abe to our letter asking whether or not he had any personal property remaining in the Protected Area. We, therefore, assume that all assets were disposed of prior to evacuation.

Claims were filed against Teruichi Abe as follows:

Standard Oil Co. of B.C. Ltd.....\$ 48.84

(rent from Sept.30/31 to Sept.30/36
at \$5.00 per month at Uchuelot)

Geo. F. Jacobs & Company..... 32.00
(back rent for premises at 614 Alexander
Street, Vancouver, B.C.)

According to our records, these claims are still outstanding but it is, of course, possible that your husband may have settled with the creditors direct.

A refund of Security Deposit for light was received from the B. C. Electric Railway Company in the amount of \$1.02 and credited to your husband's account. Our cheque for this amount, in your favour, is enclosed and the account of Teruichi Abe, in this office, is now closed. Please acknowledge receipt of this cheque.
