Mr. Torakichi Wachida, widower, Registration No. 01541, resides at Tashoo, and was born on December 15, 1889. We are informed by the R.C.M.P. that Mr. Torakichi Wachida is a Naturalized Canadian and the children are Canadian Born.

The only asset of which we have knowledge is a credit balance with the Custodian, amounting to \$1333.14. These funds were derived from the rental and sale of property known as 527 East Cordova Street and described as Lot 27, Block 53, District Lot 196, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 196.

Reference is made to your letters of the 7th and 29th dates, in which you make inquiry regarding the disposition of funds relating to the above estate.

For your information, we wish to advise you that Dr. Samuel I. Moore, Official Administrator, advised us by letter, dated January 8, 1946, that your father, Thomas Washburn, had written to him regarding this matter and he requested us to send him all particulars which we had in our office. We immediately reviewed the files of the deceased and Dr. Samuel Washburn and replied to his letter, under date of January 12, 1946, outlining information respecting assets, liabilities, etc., and stated that as far as we knew there were no liabilities. We also forwarded, with our letter, an English translation of the document signed by the deceased on May 15, 1936, and also the original Statutory Declaration, dated February 2, 1943, which was made by the witnesses who were present when the deceased signed said document.

On July 18, 1946, Mr. Moore wrote us to the effect that he had written your father for further information but had received no replies to his letters. It may be that your father has not been receiving Mr. Moore's correspondence as a result of relocating in the East. We have advised him of the new address.

Mr. Moore is particularly anxious to obtain the original Will and all accounts in connection with funeral expenses of the deceased.

It is impossible for us to assist you further in this matter as the formalities of the law must be complied with, and disbursement of funds cannot be made until Mr. Moore has completed his administration of this estate.
