In reply to your letter of December 29th we would advise that we have no accounts in the name of these three evaders and they therefore have no cash assets with the Custodian.

Miss Hikio Nishikawa declared no property or assets whatsoever. Toshio Nishikawa declared no assets but mentioned a Prudential Life policy of approximately \$230.00, policy number unknown, but in his own possession. There is no correspondence at all on the above two files.

Respecting Shoichiro Nishikawa who was originally P/W #1428 and released from internment at Angler Ontario on September 17, 1943, he declared that he had life insurance with the Crown Life Insurance Company for \$1000.00 and on March 27th our Insurance Department sent to him in care of the New Denver Sanatorium the premium notice of the above company showing a net premium due on March 25th, 1945 in the amount of \$41.73.

There is a claim against this evader of \$35.00 by Dr. C.G. Heri but the evader denied that he owed the money and Dr. Heri was advised accordingly.
