

With reference to your memo of September 1st.

A monthly remittance of \$50.00 is paid to Chuya Wakabayashi at the request of the internee, in order to reduce the balance owing on a personal debt. The original arrangement was for \$100. per month to be paid, however the income from the internee's property does not warrant such a large payment, and \$50. is the most that can be sent at this time.

The last payment was forwarded to Messrs. Norris & MacLennan on August 25th. Receipt has not been acknowledged as yet. These cheques are made payable to Chuya Wakabayashi, and are forwarded to Norris & MacLennan at the beginning of each month. The last remittance was delayed due to the fact that rents were not received from Messrs. Norris & MacLennan until quite late in the month, and Mr. Ebata's account was not large enough to cover the necessary disbursements.

We have just received a letter from Mrs. Tatsu Wakabayashi, Registration No. 02783, of Lamon Creek, Sloan, B. C., who is the wife of Chaya Wakabayashi, Registration No. 02955.

The letter is addressed for your attention and reads as follows:

"Up until the present time, I have been receiving a cheque for \$50.00 from you. The last cheque received was on July 11th. As at the present date, I have not received a cheque, I would appreciate it, if you can mail it to me without any delay.

"In future, it would be appreciated if you can send the cheque to me without my request, such as at the beginning of every month. Please give this matter your immediate attention."

We have no record in our file covering the affairs of Mrs. Wakabayashi in connection with those alleged monthly remittances of \$50.00 but our attention has been drawn by Messrs. Morris & MacLennan to the fact that at one time a cheque for \$50.00 was sent by you in connection with a claim of Chaya Wakabayashi against Yasuichi Hata amounting to \$1,000.00, the arrangement apparently being that Wakabayashi was to receive \$100.00 every month until the account was paid.

We would appreciate your providing us with the necessary particulars in order that we may reply to the communication from Mrs. Chaya Wakabayashi.

We thank you for your letter of the  
15th inst. and wish to answer your questions in the  
last paragraph as follows:

1. We are holding no credit balance for Mrs.  
Wakabayashi;
2. Not applicable;
3. The \$50.00 mentioned was remitted to Mr. Chuya  
Wakabayashi on November 28th, 1942. The \$50.00 was  
a cheque received from your office in favor of Chuya  
Wakabayashi, perhaps the husband of Katsu Wakabayashi  
although the name of the wife of Mr. Chuya Wakabayashi  
mentioned in his declaration is Tatsue, not Katsu.  
The said \$50.00 cheque from your Office was sent by  
Mr. Wright in connection with a claim of Chuya  
Wakabayashi against Yosohichi Ebata amounting to  
approximately \$1,000.00, the arrangement between Mr.  
Ebata and Mr. Wakabayashi being that Mr. Wakabayashi  
was to receive \$100.00 every month until the account  
was paid. So far circumstances have not warranted  
paying the whole \$100.00 a month.

Our records indicate that Mrs. Wakabayashi declared to us on May 8th that she had no assets and no liabilities.

We have on file a claim against her of \$34.00 placed with us by Drs. Bissett, Watson, McHaffie & Beevor-Potts of Duncan, B.C.

We would appreciate your advising us at this time:

1. As to what credit balance you are holding for Mrs. Wakabayashi.
2. The origin of such credit balance.
3. The purpose of remitting \$50.00 mentioned in her letter.
