Norris & MacLennan until quite late in the month, and Mr. Ebata's account was not large enough to cover the necessary disbursements.

We are holding no credit balance for Mrs. Wakabayashi; 2. Not applicable: 3. The \$50.00 mentioned was remitted to Mr. Chuya Wakabayashi on November 28th, 1942. The \$50.00 was a cheque received from your office in favor of Chuya Wakabayashi, perhaps the husband of Katsu Wakabayashi although the name of the wife of Mr. Chuya Wakabayashi mentioned in his declaration is Tatsue, not Katsu. The said \$50.00 cheque from your Office was sent by Mr. Wright in connection with a claim of Chuya Wakabayashi against Yosohichi Ebata amounting to approximately \$1,000.00, the arrangement between Mr. Ebata and Mr. Wakabayashi being that Mr. Wakabayashi was to receive \$100.00 every month until the account was paid.
