Mr. Taylor, husband of one of the members of the Mori family, today called on me and drew my attention to the position in connection with the funds recently received from the Prudential Insurance Company. The position is that we have received on behalf of four members of this family, the sum of \$160.83 being surrender value of their insurance policies and have been holding this pending advice from Toyoko Mori as to the correctness or otherwise of claims against him.

We have now heard from the four beneficiaries as per their joint letter of July 21st on file 3358. Their father does not acknowledge the claims, the creditors have been so advised, and in any case, there seems no reason why funds belonging to other members of his family should be retained to meet the alleged debts.

Mr. Taylor tells me that two of the insured Japanese, George and Isayo, are minors, being approximately nine and eleven respectively. I do not know if this will affect the question of payment of money to them. Of the others, Chiyo Mori our file 9576, is registered with us being seventeen years of age and has \$39.05 coming to her. The remaining Japanese, Hisako Mori (our file 9577, age nineteen) has her name wrongly spelt on the Custodian form 704 as Hisako and has \$98.39 coming to her. She is now married and, Mr. Taylor informs us, expecting her first baby. I am of the opinion that cheques should be requisitioned payable to each of these Japanese and if you agree, I will do the necessary.
