



CHATELS:

The above, in her declaration to the Custodian, dated May 19th, 1942, did not declare any chattels left in the protected area. However, on January 21/44 we were advised through the B. C. Security Commission that the above had left a trunk and a carton of clothing with a Mrs. Wood of Angus Apartments, 1531 Davie St. These were shipped to Mrs. YAMADA as per Custodian Release on file dated Jan. 24/44. We received another letter from the Department of Labour dated Dec. 12/45 advising us that Mrs. Shige YAMADA had also left a sewing machine with Mrs. Wood and that she wished this shipped to her at Lemon Creek. They advised that she was down for repatriation so thought it inadvisable to ship the machine to her at this late date. However I spoke to the Department of Labour by phone regarding this matter and it was decided to pick the machine up from Mrs. Woods and ship it to Mrs. YAMADA. This is being done this week.

The above declared a \$50.00 Victory Bond in her own possession. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The above has a sewing machine stored with Mrs. R. W. Wood, Angus Apartments, Vancouver, telephone Pacific 1004, which she has requested be shipped to Lemon Creek, and has deposited \$7.00.

This woman is a Japanese National and has asked for repatriation. Under these circumstances it would seem best to either leave the machine with Mrs. Wood, or to have it turned over to the Custodian here to sell or to store until opportunity arrives to ship to Japan, if such is desired. It is entirely unlikely that sewing machines will accompany repatriates to Japan account shortage of shipping space. Am arranging to refund the \$7.00.

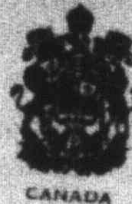
