This man signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 20, 1942. He had been evacuated on March 12, 1942, but would appear to have returned to Vancouver. It is probable that he finally left the protected area on May 22, 1942, at the time his wife was evacuated.

Chattels: Eiji INOUE declared, kitchen utensils, one bed, one Singer Sewing Machine at the Japanese schoolhouse, Paldi, in the care of the Mayo Lumber Co. Similar articles were declared by his wife, Yumi, File 7663, and it would appear from her file that all her chattels were shipped to her.

Securities: Victory Bond \$50.00 and War Savings Certificate \$5.00, in owner's possession. These did not come under the control of this office.
