

in his declaration of May 20, 1942, Asao Sakata declared a box of kitchen utensils located at #35 Gulf of Georgia Cannery House. The file reveals that these items were never found by the Custodian.

A letter from the B. C. Packers, dated September 21, 1943, reveals that they had in their possession a cohee net, belonging to Asao Sakata, and which, they state, was in rags and of no value. As Asao Sakata did not reply to our letter of September 27, 1943, we notified the B. C. Packers that it would be in order to scrap this net.


