We note from your report of search of titles owned by the Japan & Canada Trust Savings Co. accompanying your memorandum to Mr. F. Field of June 21st., you show a report on Lot 12 Blk 12 D.L.184 that the name of Registrant is Kiene Takahashi. This should not appear other than as the property of the above Co..

A mortgage was originally given by Kikiusuke Takahashi and when he died the Title was taken by executrix Kuno Takahashi who subsequently gave Deed of Land to Japan & Canada Trust Svgs Co. dated August 31/40. This deed was registered on May 11th and Title issued to the Co. on May 13th 1942.

We might add to the above that when the writer took over the management of the Co. he was informed that there existed an understanding that should the property be sold for more than the debt of mortgage, the balance would be handed over to Mrs. (Kuno) Takahashi. We find however that there is little possibility that the property will realise the amount of Mortgage and interest.

Dear Sir:

Re: Kuno TAKAHASHI - Int. File #125.

Referring to yours of June 29th last, in respect to Lot 12, Block 12, District Lot 184, Group 1, Plan 178, New Westminster District: Mrs. Kuno TAKAHASHI registered with the Custodian on the 20th of May, 1942 declaring that she had no real property. It was discovered however, that the above described land was assessed to her by the city and Title to the parcel was searched in order to ascertain her interest therein. I have not a copy of my memorandum to Mr. Field of June 21st, my search record being dated August 10th, 1942 and showing Title in the name of the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Co. Mrs. Takahashi had then an apparent interest in the property. Her name together with that of the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company appeared on the Vesting Order dated August 24th, 1942 and Certificate of Encumbrance was received in respect thereto on the 7th of October, 1942.

I am attaching herewith a copy of a search made on the 3rd instant together with copies of the Vesting Certificate of last August and copy of Certificate of Encumbrance of last October.

This may explain to you why Mrs. Takahashi's name appears on a search as registrant, as we had some evidence of her interest in the land and have no knowledge of her having executed a deed to the Japan and Canada Trust Savings Company.
