Dear Sir:

Your letter of August 6th has, in view of the contents of same, been referred to me for attention.

In order that there may be no misunderstanding as to the position of the Custodian, I would point out that he is at liberty to take such action as he considers desirable to protect assets left in this area by any person of the Japanese race. He cannot and will not accept any responsibility for property left in this area which is hidden or stored in such a manner that his officers cannot locate and examine same.

For the time being the articles in the attic are not being disturbed but if the Custodian desires to disturb same he will do so, and until he examines the contents of the attic he will assume no responsibility for the safe custody of such goods.

As regards your furniture, the Custodian has no objection to having same shipped to you, provided your debts in this area have been paid, and provided you pay the expenses.
