Tamayo Fujiwara died at New Denver, B. C. on December 5, 1942. She was survived by her husband, Kitaro FUJIWARA, File No. 11798, and three daughters, Masako, File No. 12096; Ykiko, File No. 9633; and Kiyoko (Mrs. Iutaka MUKAI), File No. 6183.

Mrs. Fujiwara signed a "No Property" card on May 20, 1942, and her file does not reveal any assets.

The B. C. Security Commission filed a claim for \$50.00 to cover the cost of burial of the deceased. Mr. Kitaro Fujiwara was advised of this claim but replied as follows: "I have no way to meet the huge sum I owe." There are also claims against Kitaro Fujiwara by the Provincial Board of Health for \$2943.00, Royal Columbian Hospital for \$170.00, and H. Nishiguchi Co. Ltd. for \$174.10.
