This woman signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 20, 1942, in which she reported that she owned no property of any kind in the property area.

However, the R.C.M.P. handed to this office a Kodak camera and a Victor radio surrendered by this woman. The Kodak camera was shipped to Mrs. MIYASHITA on May 4, 1943 through the B. C. Security Commission and the radio was sold at auction and the net proceeds of \$12.09 credited to the account of this woman. This is being held awaiting return of receipt, for which we are writing her today.
