MEMORANDUM

TO: Mr. Shears

Plan 730, Mrs. Yoko TAKEMAKA.

Mrs. TAKEMAKA declared to the Custodian that she owned no real property. We received a tax notice from the City in the name of Yoko ITO (former name of Mrs. TAKEMAKA) and visited the property, assuming an interest from the tax notice. The title of the land is in the name of Maggie Starnouth, on investigation we find that Mr. Starnouth gave an Agreement of Sale to Yoko ITO, September 6th, 1930, and on the 19th February, 1941, Mrs. TAKEMAKA quit claimed to Mrs. Starnouth. It would appear from this record, that Mrs. TAKEMAKA has no interest in the property, and I attach hereto a Vacating Certificate to permit the registration of a Deed on the request of Mr. A.H. McRobbie, who also assures me that no Japanese interest exists.



VACATING CERTIFICATE

The Secretary of State of Canada acting in his capacity as Custodian under or by virtue of the Revised Regulations Respecting Trading with the Enemy (1943), by his duly authorized and lawful Deputy, hereby vacates the Certificate of Vesting dated July 8th, 1943, registered in the Land Registry Office for the Land Registration District of New Westminster at Vancouver in the Province of British Columbia, on the 21st day of July, 1943, as No. 36577, and certifying that the interest of Waka TAKENAKA in City of Vancouver, Westerly half (½) of Lot 5, Block 335, District Lot 526, Group 1, New Westminster District, Plan 590, is vested in the Custodian, and hereby relinquishes and releases any right which he, the said Custodian, may have in the said property by virtue of the vesting in him of the interest of the said Waka TAKENAKA.
