We have had a request from Miss Kikuye Tanizawa to sell her belongings and send her the money. These were left in the house at 786 West 8th in which the position of chattels is as set out in my memorandum of October 29th last year and yours of November 3rd on files 12971 and 1438/1.

You will see that she claims some items left in the upstairs room which had been moved, together with some left in the basement and the shed in the back garden which have not yet been moved. This calls for no action at present but when moving is undertaken and the articles sold, it will probably be necessary to hold proceeds of sale pending separation by the owners of the proceeds.
