GENERAL SUMMARY

Re: Miho MAEBA, Reg. No. 01537

This woman is the wife of Shinichi MAEBA, File No. 10632. She signed a declaration to the Custodian on May 21, 1942. She was evacuated on June 3, 1942.

In her declaration, Mrs. MAEBA reported chattels located at 230 1/2 Alexander Street, Vancouver. This was the residence of Mrs. MAEBA. The premises were the property of Mr. Machida, 332 Alexander Street, File 8861. The chattels reported by Mrs. MAEBA were,

On July 6, 1942, Kiyoshi IKUTA, Reg. No. 13450, reported to this office that all the furniture belonging to Mrs. MAEBA had been sold. This information was sent to Mrs. MAEBA, on July 20, 1942, and On August 7, 1942, she wrote this office stating that when she left Vancouver she had given Kiyoshi IKUTA power to sell any goods he was able to, and that if he informed this office that these had been sold, it would not be necessary for the Custodian to be responsible for her belonging in the protected area. However, on July 6, 1943, Shinichi MAEBA reported to the Custodian that he had left at 336 Alexander Street, the articles marked x in the above list., while the case of books shown above was listed as two cases of books at 230 Alexander Street. Shinichi MAEBA has expressed dissatisfaction regarding the handling of his chattels. From this it would seem that instead of selling the goods as reported, Kiyoshi IKUTA had moved the greater part of the chattels to 336 Alexander Street. Goods identified as the property of Shinichi MAEBA were found at 336 Alexander Street. Other goods without identification found at 336 Alexander Street and 230 Alexander Street were assumed to be the property of Denkichin MACHIDA and of Taiyo Printing Co. respectively. Some of the goods without identification may be the property of Shinichi MAEBA.

Mrs. MAEBA declared no property other than the chattels, and no other property is revealed by her file.

The file of Mrs. MAEBA reveals no liabilities.
