Re: DOI, Tomoaki, file 10835
MIZUTANI, Tomiye (Mrs. Tsuneichi, file 9764)

On July 8th, T. Doi asked to have a dresser shipped to him along with other goods. When they arrived he wrote that it was not his dresser but one belonging to T. Mizutani.

On August 20th, Mr. Uyesugi (file 463), a brother-in-law of T. Mizutani, was given permission to come to Steveston to arrange for shipment of the sister's dresser and other goods which were stored in Doi's house, as mentioned in second paragraph of memo dated August 22/44. The dresser had already been sent to Doi, so it was arranged that he (Uyesugi) would pick up Doi's dresser and send it to his sister at Tashme, as well as some cups and saucers previously asked for. These were then to be transferred to Doi at Ashcroft in exchange for Mizutani's dresser.

Mr. Uyesugi and his mother were, as you know, down here the other day and with our consent, went out to Steveston and picked up from Mrs. Egan, the following items for transfer to the under-noted Japanese.

(1) Mr. Tamaoki DOI, file 10835 -- dresser, cups and saucers.

(2) Mrs. Tsuneichi MIZUTANI, file 9764 -- one double bed, two carpets, one musical instrument.

I have made two extra copies of this memo which perhaps you will place on the files of these two other Japanese together with a notation of just what is the final position about these shipments. I understand that they are arranging between themselves to exchange the items previously sent to the wrong parties.
