31-year old Canadian-born Millhand from Ganges, Salt Spring Island, signed a Custodian "JP" declaration form on May 5th, 1942. Evacuated June 1st, 1942. His wife, also Canadian-born, whose file (9791) is closed, signed a Custodian "No Property" card on May 20th, 1942, at which time she declared she was separated from her husband.

Chattels: None.

Accounts Receivable: None.

Bonds, shares, etc.: Declared Victory Bond (\$50.00) and War Savings Certificates (\$90.00) to be in his possession, and so left.

Life Insurance: None.

Bank Accounts: A balance of \$50.00 in a Savings Account with the Royal Bank, Main and Hastings Sts., Vancouver, was not disturbed.

Funds: \$700.00 of the balance of \$738.10 in this account was received from his father (Tsunetaro MURAKAMI, File 3277) on the 9th February, 1946; the remainder being refund of National Defence Tax (\$38.10).
