MEMORANDUM

File No. 9819

November 4, 1946.

Masao NOCHIZUKI, husband of Nebu NOCHIZUKI, died at Kamloops on March 9, 1944. The only asset in the hands of the Custodian was a credit balance of \$29.38, derived from the sale of the deceased's radio.

Letters of Administration were issued to P. J. Wilson, Official Administrator, Lillooet, and the credit balance standing to the credit of the deceased in this office was remitted to him on October 29, 1946. The Administrator advised us that the funds would be distributed among the widow and her four minor children. He was advised by this office on November 4, 1946, that the Custodian had no objection to these funds being paid direct to the widow.
