

The above Evacuee declared several items to be left at 1525 W. 6th Ave., Vancouver, B. C. (property registered by her husband), but all the furniture of this Evacuee was sold or disposed of privately by the family, with the exception of 3 old beds with springs which were in such a dilapidated condition that they were not worth moving. Under date of June 20/45 we have a letter on file signed by the husband, Chiyoji Matsuo (File 1624) confirming that all personal property formerly at 1525 W. 6th Avenue has been sold or otherwise disposed of.
