CHATTTEL SUMMARY

Evacuated September 11, 1942

In her declaration of May 22, 1942, Mrs. Fumi Nakamoto declared goods left in the home of Kiyoshi Imai, File No. 9979 - see Schedule.

The disposition of the chattels is as follows:

The Pantex pressing machine and the chesterfield suite were sold before evacuation by Mrs. Nakamoto, see her letter of July 3, 1942.

The 2 double beds were taken by Mrs. Nakamoto, see letter of July 24, 1942.

The tailor sewing machine and 1 clock were shipped to Mrs. Nakamoto on May 20, 1943.

The balance of the chattels, 1 kitchen stove and 1 round kitchen table, were auctioned by the Custodian and the proceeds credited to Mrs. Nakamoto's account.

In addition to what she declared, a list sent to the Custodian on August 12, 1942, by Kiyoshi Imai, reveals that Mrs. Nakamoto was the owner of a bamboo book case, 1 trunk, 1 wardrobe with glass and 1 dark varnished showcase. This last item was never found by the Custodian. Although the first 3 items were inventoried originally by the Custodian's agent, there is no record of these items being sold.


