Re: Mrs. Sugi MURATA, #02575, Deceased.

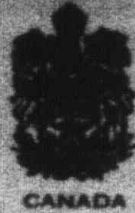


