MR. JOHNSTON:

According to information on file, Nisa (Mrs. Yasaburo) NAKANO died on November 24, 1944.

Assets of the deceased consisted of 1 Marconi Radio and 1 Kodak Camera, which were sold at a total net price of \$49.33.

B. C. Security Commission filed claim of \$80.00 against this Estate covering funeral expenses of Mrs. NAKANO, and claims of \$20.00 by the Commission covering funeral expenses of NAKANO infant, and \$1.91 filed by the B. C. Electric Railway Company, were filed against Mr. & Mrs. NAKANO.

The claim of the B. C. Electric Railway Company has been paid, and in view of the small credit balance in the accounts of the above named, the Commission withdrew their claims of \$80.00 and \$20.00 for funeral expenses.

In view of the fact that balances of the accounts of the deceased and her husband have been forwarded to Yasaburo NAKANO, it would appear that the matter of the Estate herein has been dealt with.

I note that Mrs. Hakano, Deceased, owned a
Kodak, which, with Mr. Shear's approval, may now be sold. The
proceeds up to the sum of \$45.34 may be paid to the B. C. Security
Commission to apply on their \$80.00 funeral claim. ①

I note also that Yasaburo Hakano has a set of
Encyclopedia which apparently still remains in the Fairview Buddhist
Temple basement at 715 W. 7th Avenue. It might be advisable to have
this sold at this time in order that the father might be in a position
to clear off his indebtedness in full. It was suggested by Mrs. Crosby
of the B. C. Security Commission that owing to the scant assets of this
man they would not press their claim for funeral expenses, but as far
as the \$80.00 for Nisa Hakano is concerned we will either apply her small
estate on the bill for her funeral, or we will have to have it
administered. The reasonable procedure would appear to be to pay the
burial costs. In the meantime, the assets of both may be liquidated and
Hakano's money will be liable for payment of the child's burial and any
balance due of his wife's burial and the B. C. Electric. Any remission
of debt by the Commission as far as these obligations to them are
concerned will of course be accepted by us. ②

Reg. No. 03728, Deceased.

The above Japanese person died on November 24th, 1944 at Sloan Community Hospital, New Denver. She died intestate as far as we know, her only assets being a credit with the Custodian of \$34.58 being proceeds from the sale of a radio, and an unsold folding Kodak appraised at \$16.00.

The B. C. Security Commission has submitted a claim in the sum of \$50.00 for funeral expenses. There are surviving the husband and at least three infant children. As far as the husband's file is concerned he appears to have no assets with the exception of a set of Encyclopedia stored in the Fairview Buddhist Temple basement and a cash credit of \$21.07 with the Custodian. Against this are filed two claims, one from the B. C. Electric for \$1.91 and the other for \$20.00 for burial of a deceased infant who died at New Denver on November 24, 1944.

Would you recommend selling the Kodak and applying the available cash on the funeral debt without Administration of the Estate? *While up to the present to Admin. rule has been set down as to disposition of cameras, Mr. Shears is agreeable to selling this one.*
