Enclosed herewith find our cheque No. 2095 for \$25.24 in part payment of Dr. Haig's claim of \$90.00 against the above named. These funds represent the sale of some chattels belonging to his mother, and we have no further funds belonging to Mrs. SUZUKI or her son. In order that you may know the position of these people at the present time, we are giving you below an extract from a letter received from the Supervisor in Greenwood for the B. C. Security Commission.

"These people have been destitute since arriving in Greenwood, Mrs. Suzuki being a chronic invalid and Bob Suzuki being disabled by reason of tubercular affections of the bone and they are without any means of liquidating this claim.

"They inform us that their household possessions, etc., were left in the hands of the Custodian and agreed that any funds which may be in the Custodian's hands may be applied against this claim. They have not received any certificate from the Custodian, of Assets in the Custodian's hands. Please advise Mr. McAlister of the Claims Department to this effect."
