According to information on the Release fort, these goods were stored in the Fukushima house at the Acme Campary, Eburne, B.C. the file indicates that sulpment was made on June 1, 1943, but that the wrong sewing sechine was intered. The correct machine was shipped co July 23, 1949. The machine provincially shipped appears to have belonged to a Mrs. Herry Postentina who was also at Slocus. On May 22, 1943, the sum of \$43.08 was received for the credit of the account of Cholire Yoshimoto in this office, being refund of Mattonal Defence Text. 
