CHATELS:

The above, who made her declaration to the Custodian on May 25, 1942, and was evacuated on September 12, 1942, declared the following goods left in the care of Mr. E. Clester, Woodfibre, B.C.

Bedroom suite
Sewing machine
Kitchenware, box of chinaware & silverware

These goods were shipped, apparently by the representative of the B.C. Security Commission at Woodfibre, to the above at Tashme. See letter on file of Hisao KUWADA, husband of the above, File 896, dated May 13th, 1943, stating that these goods were shipped to Mrs. KUWADA on May 13th, 1943.

A Custodian release dated June 25, 1942, appears on this file, 9945 stating that 1 box of kitchenware, 2 washtubs and 1 stove (crated) were released to Mrs. KUWADA at Hastings Park from 992 Powell St. There is no evidence on either her file or the file of her husband to show how these articles came from Woodfibre to 992 Powell St. It is possible they brought them with them and they were stored at 992 Powell St. temporarily.

There is a letter on file dated July 16, 1942, directed to Mr. Saunders, Baggage Dept., Hastings Park, from Mr. H.F. Green, authorizing the Crone Storage Company to release effects belonging to Mrs. KUWADA. There is no other reference on file as to what these goods were or how they came to be stored at Crone Storage. It must be assumed that Mr. or Mrs. KUWADA had stored goods there without the knowledge of the Custodian. Whether or not these goods were released to Mr. Saunders and from him to the above owner, the file does not reveal.

LIFE
INSURANCE:

The above declares a \$1000.00 life insurance policy with the Sun Life Company. This did not come under the control of the Custodian.

The file reveals that the above did not own any specified articles.

No property interests other than those mentioned above are found on this file.
