Dear Sir:

In view of your remarks to the Department of Labour, Japanese Division, that a number of articles formerly declared by you were not shown on the auction sheets forwarded to you by this office, we wrote to you on February 13, 1946 requesting you to again go carefully through the auction sheets and give us a list of the articles said to be missing from our auction lists. To date no reply has been received to our letter.

We now find, on reviewing chattels in connection with your file, that goods belonging to Mr. Kunetaro KUBO and Mrs. Sadaki MATSUMIYA were declared by them as having been left at 8730 Selkirk Street, Vancouver, and in the absence of identification marks all personal property was removed to storage at 8757 Selkirk Street and later sold at public auction under your name. We would now ask you to examine the auction lists and advise us what goods belonged to the above persons in order that we may credit their accounts with their proportion of the chattel proceeds.

Kindly let us hear from you soon relative to the ownership of all chattels sold under your name as no funds can be released to you until ownership of chattels has been clarified.
