BONDS: The following were declared by Mrs. Suzuki in her JP form dated May 23, 1942:

\$100.00 Victory Bond
2 - \$ 50.00 Victory Bonds "in declarant's possession".

According to a letter received from the Administration & Trust Company dated December 2, 1943 it would appear that the above Bonds were left with them in safekeeping. On December 20, 1943 the Custodian advised the above company that we would have no objection to these Bonds being returned to the owner and they could so advise the Suzukis. No further reference to these bonds is made on file.

LIFE
INSURANCE:

Mrs. Suzuki declared in her JP form a \$1000.00 Sun Life Assurance Co. Policy No. 660190, beneficiary being her son Kaoru. A letter dated Oct. 13/44 on file from the Sun Life advised that the above policy matured on October 10, 1944 and that Mrs. Suzuki wished to leave the sum assured of \$1000.00 on deposit with them, and at their request we forwarded to them the policy contract on October 20, 1944. Correspondence on file dated October 23, 1944 and October 24, 1944 reveals that a cheque for \$22.65, representing accumulated dividends under the above policy, was remitted by the Sun Life through this office to Mrs. Suzuki.


Some correspondence appears on this file relative to Mr. Sentaro Suzuki's (husband) life insurance but this is dealt with on his file, 9957.

BANK

ACCOUNT: In her JP form Mrs. Suzuki declared "Royal Bank of Canada" - None. The word "closed" is written in ink over the word 'none', indicating that she possibly closed her account in the above Bank between time she made her declaration, May 2, 1942 and the date of her evacuation, namely October 15, 1942.

NO OTHER PERSONAL OR REAL PROPERTY BELONGING TO THE ABOVE JAPANESE PERSON IS REVEALED ON THIS FILE.

Confirming our telephone conversation with Mr. Jackson this morning, we regret that your letter of the 2nd instant regarding documents in your hands belonging to the above has not been replied to earlier. As explained, with the exception of the three Victory Bonds you mention we shall be glad if you will kindly send us all the other documents, as the life and fire policies will be handed on to our Insurance Department and this department should have the Deeds relating to the various parcels of properties owned by Suzuki, as some of these are at present in the course of sale and other will doubtless be sold from time to time.

So far as the bonds are concerned, it will be in order for you to write to the Suzukis advising that you have heard from us regarding these and that if they wish to have same returned to them we have no objection. Doubtless they would prefer this in order that they might cash the coupons from time to time.

Respecting the third paragraph of your letter under reply on the question of transferring \$250.00 of insurance covering the piano, we understand you have already seen to this and that the endorsement has been made out.

If you will kindly see that the documents mentioned are sent addressed to the write, he will see that they are passed on to the right department.

We wish to acknowledge your letter of November 19th concerning the above numbered policy. We are advised by the Sun Life that this policy will mature on November 24th, 1945. At that time if the policyholder wishes to leave the proceeds with the Company, he may do so.

In the meantime there is a net premium of \$42.91 due on this policy as at November 24th and with the 30 days of grace allowed this will have to be paid prior to the 24th of December.

We have received a post card from your daughter Aya, asking us to pay this premium. The account in this office as you probably know, is in the name of your husband and we will be glad to take care of this premium payment for him from money standing to his credit upon receipt of a signed request by your husband to that effect. I am attaching hereto a letter addressed to ourselves and if your husband wishes this premium paid, please have him sign it and return it immediately.
